


F-15 in 1/144... no problem isn't it? Plenty to choose from.


## 1/144 F-15A 72-0119 Streak Eagle



There are certain details that will help converting most common F-15E model into an A-version available in our SO21446 detail set. These are:

- turkey feather exhausts
- early version main wheel hubs
- telemetry antenna (the white one under the canopy)
- instrument panel

Select "Actual Size" option in Reader print options, this will result in true 1/144 scale drawings on A4 format. This may come handy for creating mask templates.
