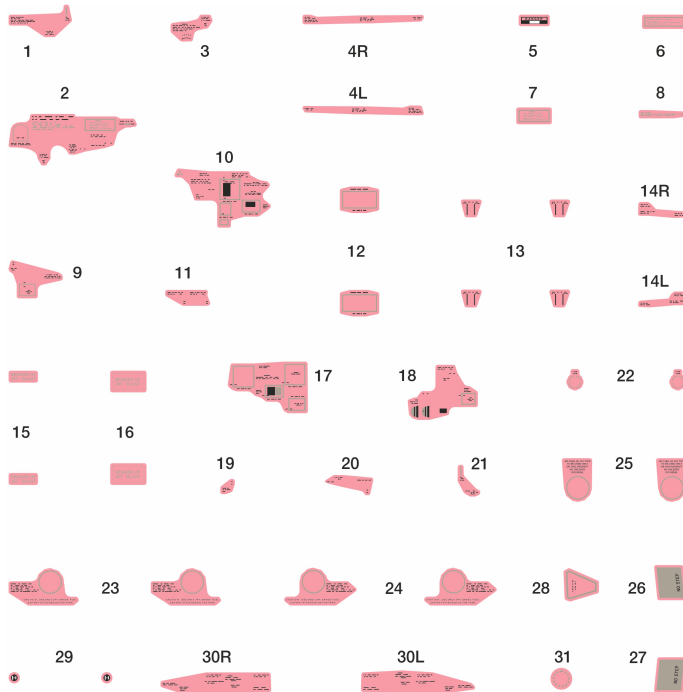

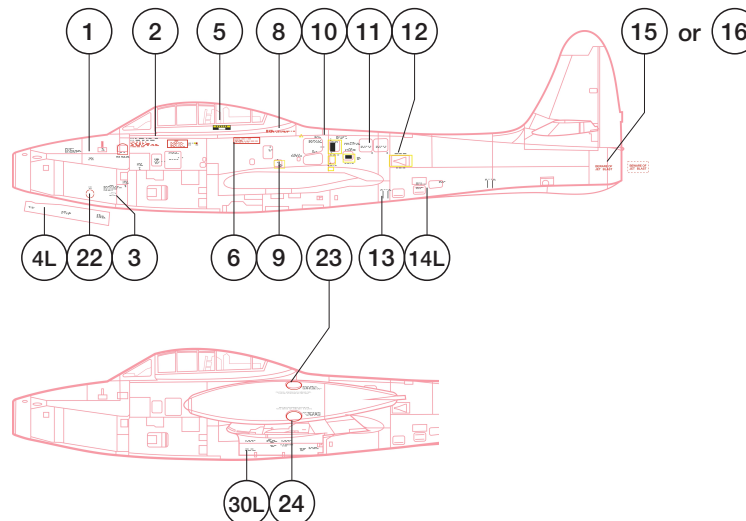
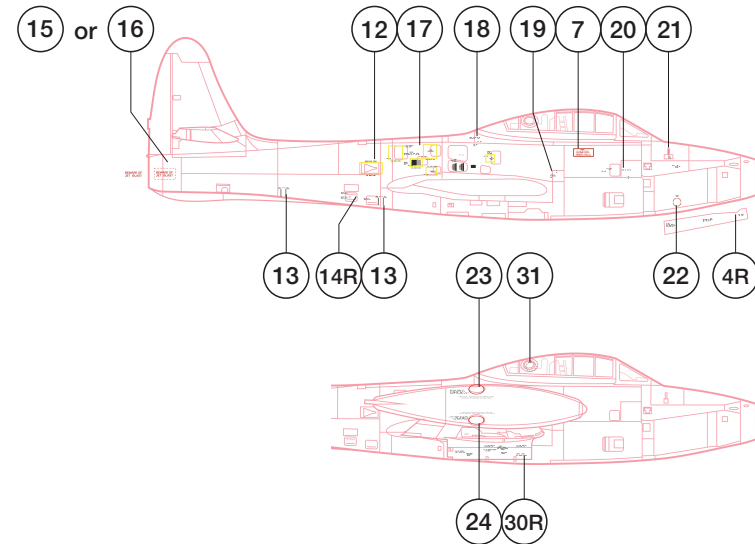

Thunderjets were not known for having excess power. The Allison J35 struggled to get the airplane airborne with anything more than a pilot onboard. Lack of kilonewtons in powerplant compartment was offset by abundance of stencils across the fuselage.

Our stencils are the ones visible on top and on both sides of the airplane. We really see little point in adding decals that go at the bottom of fuselage and will never be seen again. If your opinion differs - sorry :)
