Finnish Air Forces flew Drakens between 1972 and 2000. This was preceded by negotiations with Sweden reaching back to early 1960s, but only gained pace almost 10 years later. Initially six J35B aircraft were leased from Sweden in 1972 (redeemed in 1976) with six J35F and three SK35C purchased at the same time. Further eighteen J35F were purchased at the beginning of 1980s and delivered in 1984-86, including a single J35B replacement for DK-206 which was destroyed by engine fire. With the arrival of the F/A-18 Hornet in the mid-1990s the process of phasing out begun, seeing Drakens initially moved to 11th squadron in Rovaniemi Air Base, and then gradually leave their posts between 1997-2000.

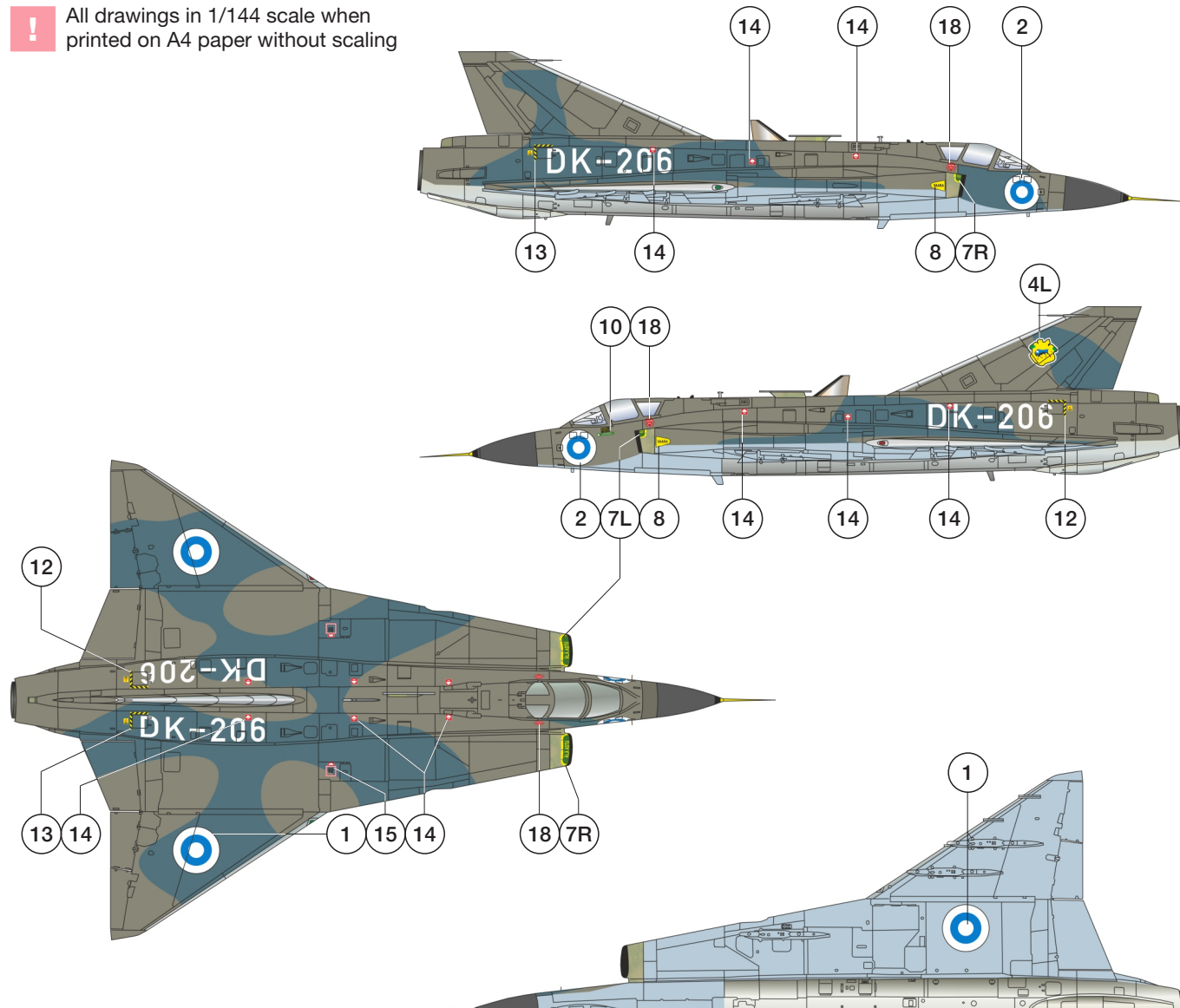
Redesignated to DK-942 used at the Air Force Technical School, further redesignated DK-206A at Ähtäriä, scrapped in August 2002.
