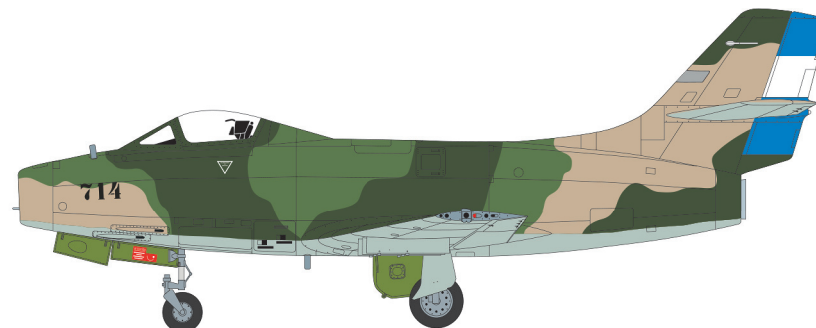
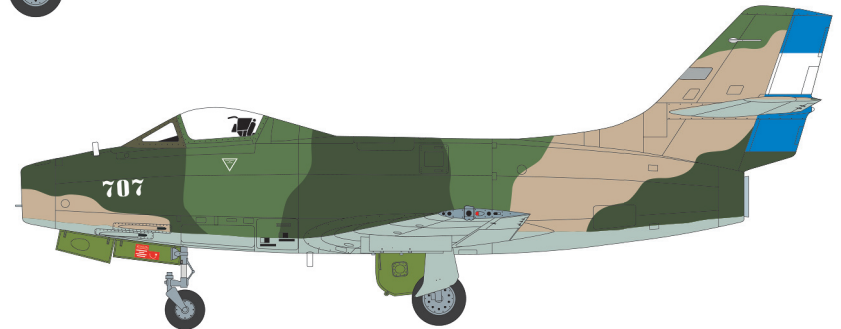
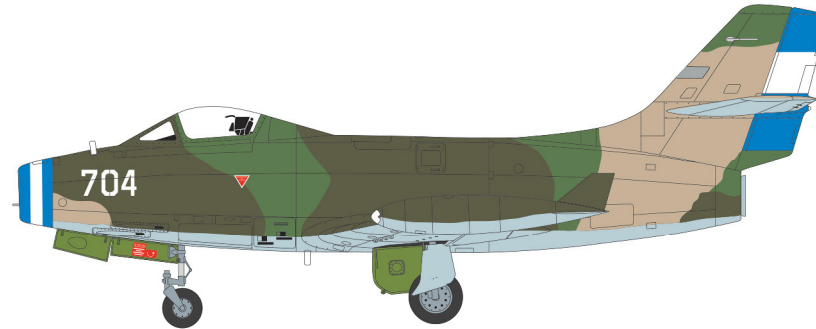


This decal set is recommended for Miniwing kits – both resin and plastic releases. Decals are made using silk print technology (BOA Bodecek Agency) and feature a limited amount of transparent base around the graphics.

This set depicts five Ouragans out of 18 purchased by Salvadorean Air Forces from Israel in 1975. These were the last Ouragans in military service in the World - the last flight in service took place in 1989. The later try to put them back into air in 2001 has been unsuccessful.

A small PE fret included in this set contains two types of antennae of Israeli origin as well as the imitations of eight 2-piece under wing hardpoints with the pattern for their positioning.

To additionally enhance your model, a SO2144016 PE detail set can be used. It contains flat wingtip plates featured by FAS machines often operated without their wingtip fuel tanks to save weight and carry a greater number of ordnance.

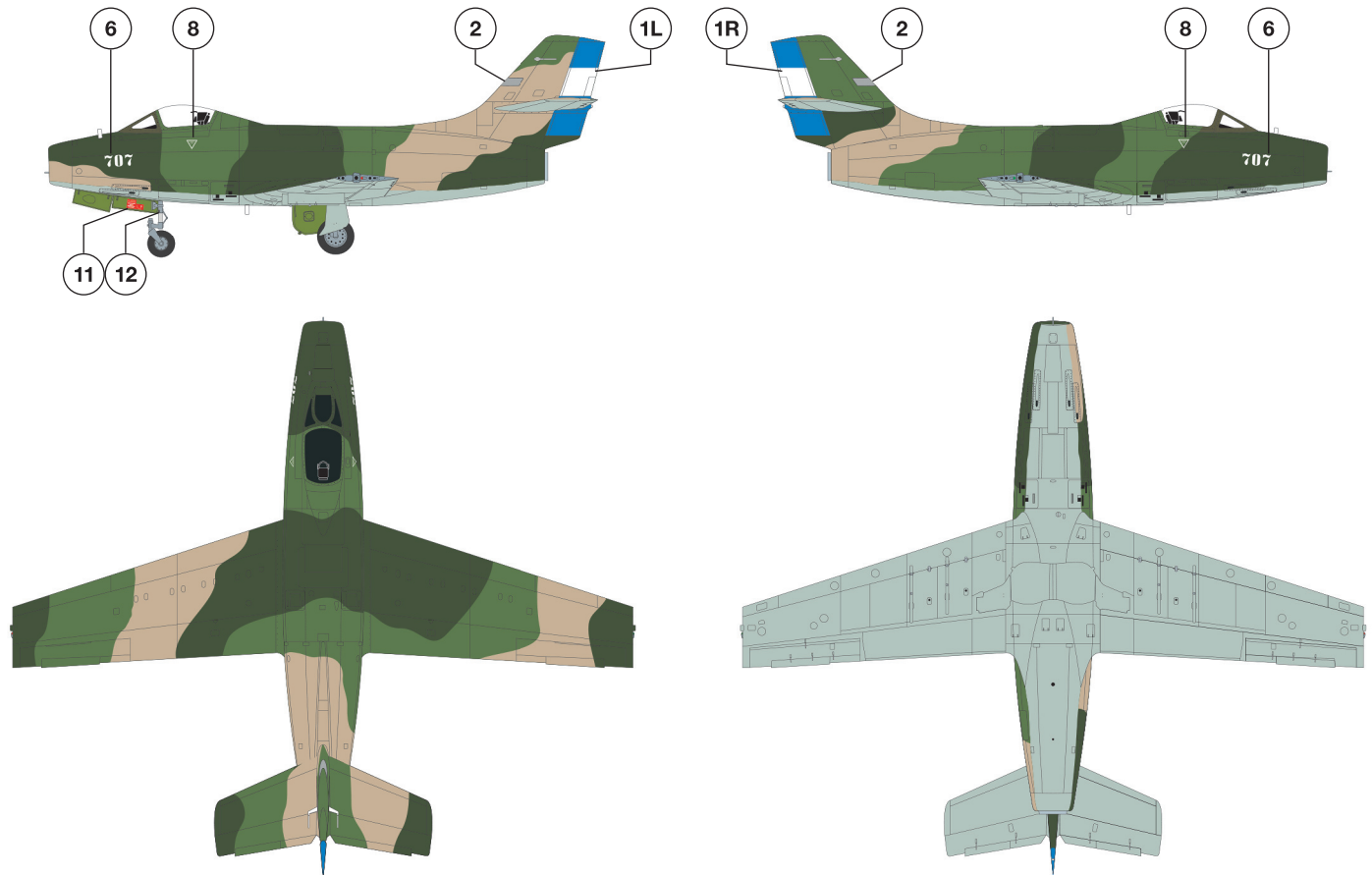

Additional antennae are very light, presumably white.

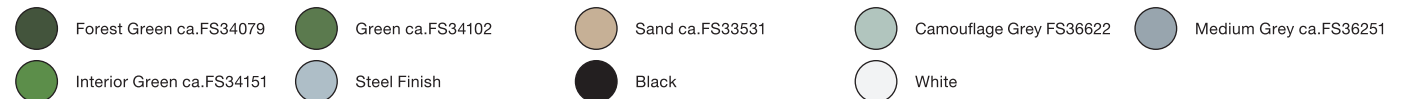

The machine is depicted in its final version of camouflage, which may include some touch ups and repairs giving it an unusual splotchy feel. Unfortunately the exact colours are unknown – it may seem like a standard IDF/USAF EuroOne schemes mix.

Cockpit interior kept in black.

The inner surfaces of landing gear doors are Interior Green, gear legs as well as wheel hubs are Medium Grey.

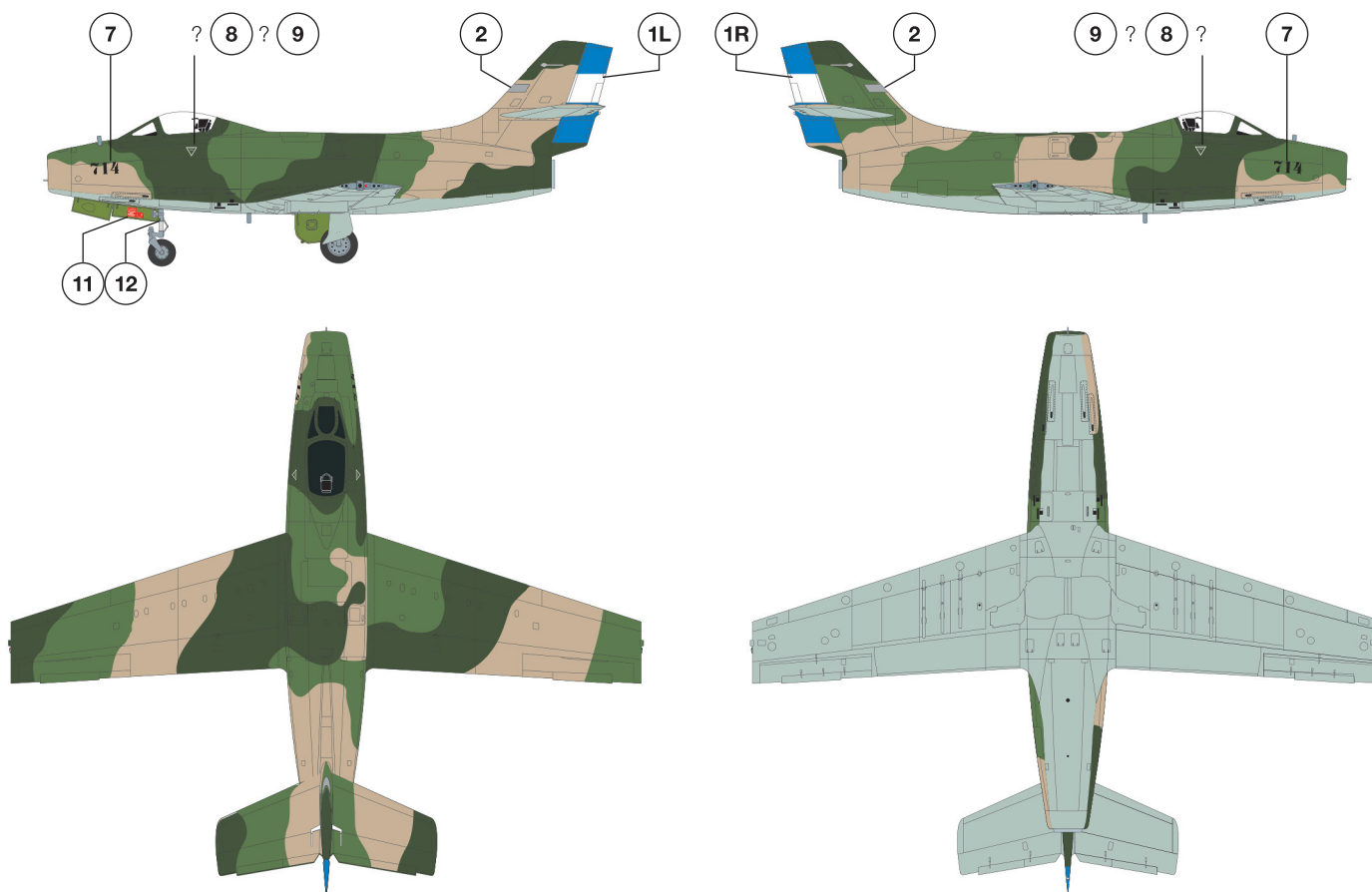
Additional antennae on the tail are very light, presumably white. The two front antennae are closer to Medium Grey.

The presence of the ejection seat warning triangles is disputable, one of the existing photos this a/c depicting its port side does not show any triangle. Moreover, two versions of this marking were used in the final stages of Ouragan service in FAS. These are represented as decals **8** or **9**.

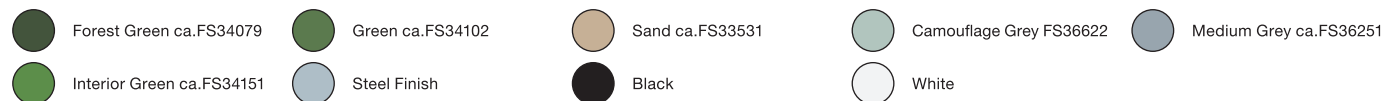
The machine is shown without wingtip tanks, as visible on the existing photos of this a/c – the endplates are Medium Grey.

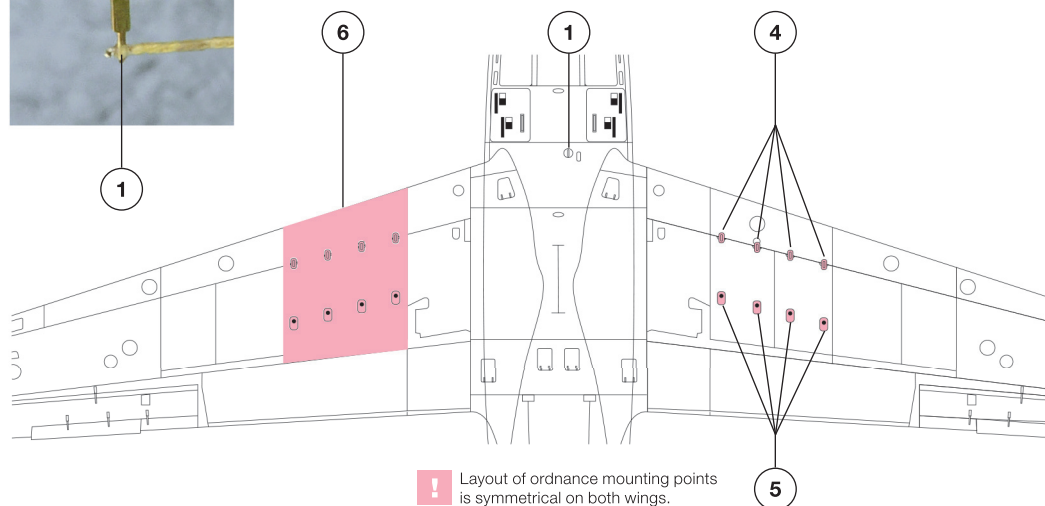
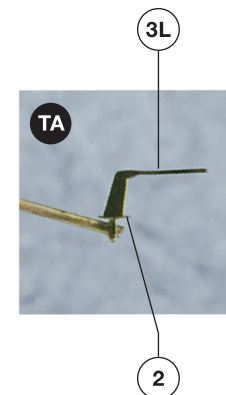
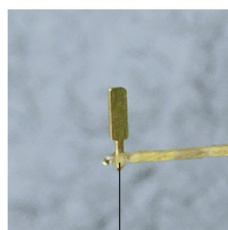
Scheme of PE parts placement.

Note: both blade antennae (1) were fitted off the main longitudinal fuselage axis.

Use brass pattern (6) to position front and rear ordnance mounting points. under each wing. The pattern can be positioned using panel lines on the model.

Several smaller parts are supplied in bigger quantities than needed – one must take proper care of its always hungry woven floor pet.

 Use part 3R for the starboard assembly.



 Layout of ordnance mounting points is symmetrical on both wings.
