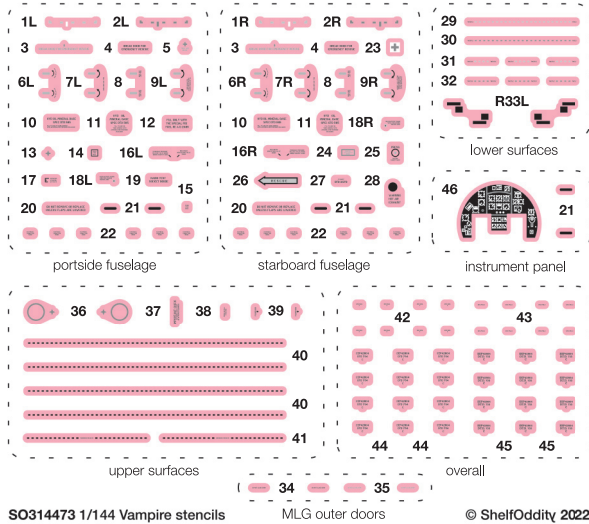

This decal set is recommended for Mark I kits. Decals are made using silk print technology (BOA Bodecek Agency) and feature a limited amount of transparent base around the graphics.

We have prepared a full set of stencils for single seater Vampire but beside our placement guide check your references on the exact machine you are building. Sometimes only some of stencils were visible or were used in various combinations.

The red *KEEP OFF* boxes should be taken from the decal sheet supplied with the kit.

The instruments panel decal (46) matches part no. 1 from our SO214431 photo-etched set (in preparation).

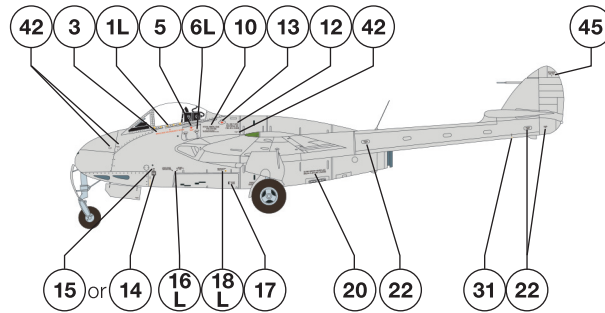

! Drawings keep 1/144 scale when printed on A4 size paper without "fit to page" option.

! Stencil 5 was most often used in conjunction with 6L/R or 8. Check your references.

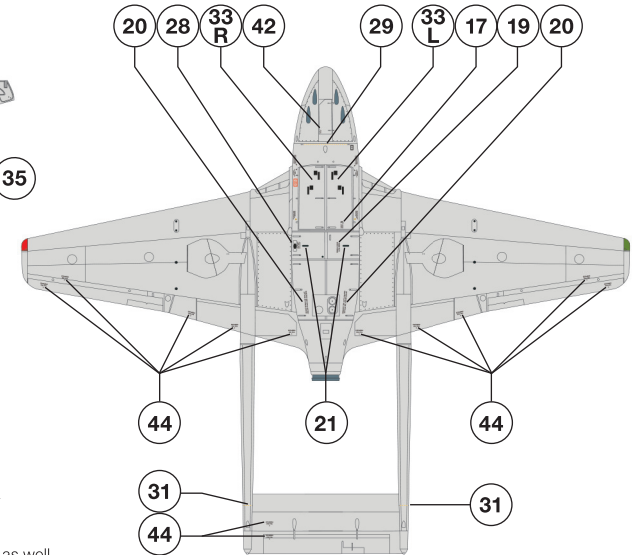
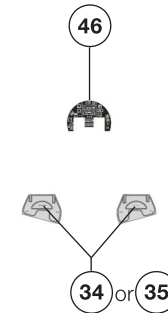
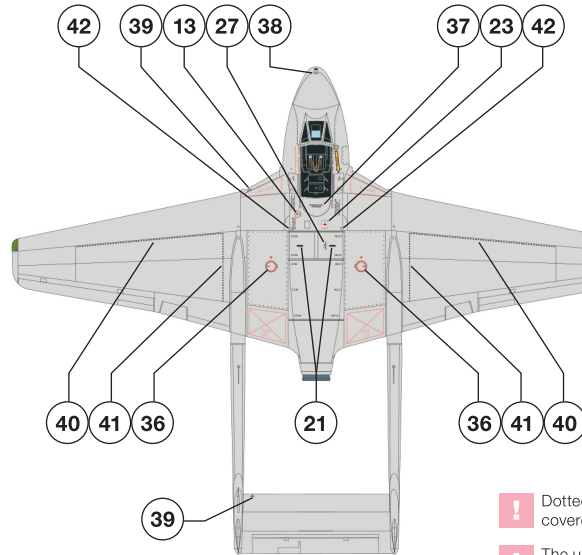
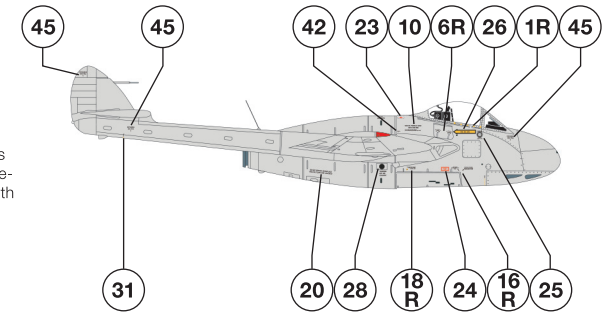
! Stencils 1L/R (yellow) and 2L/R (red) were used interchangeably. Most likely in conjunction with the colour of *Trestle* stripes.

! Stencil sets 6L/R, 7L/R, 8 and 9L/R were used interchangeably.



! Stencils 3 (or 4) and 10 (or 11) and 20 (or 23) were used interchangeably.

! Starboard stencils 3 (or 4) were sometimes replaced with an arrow (26).



! Dotted lines 40 were partially covered with RAF roundels.

! The use of stencils 42 (or 43) as well as 44 (or 45) depends on the selected machine. Some of those were not always used. Check your references.

! Stencils 44 (or 45) on the lower part of the wing were most often present.

! Use yellow (29, 31) or red (30, 32) versions of *Trestle* stripes separately.
