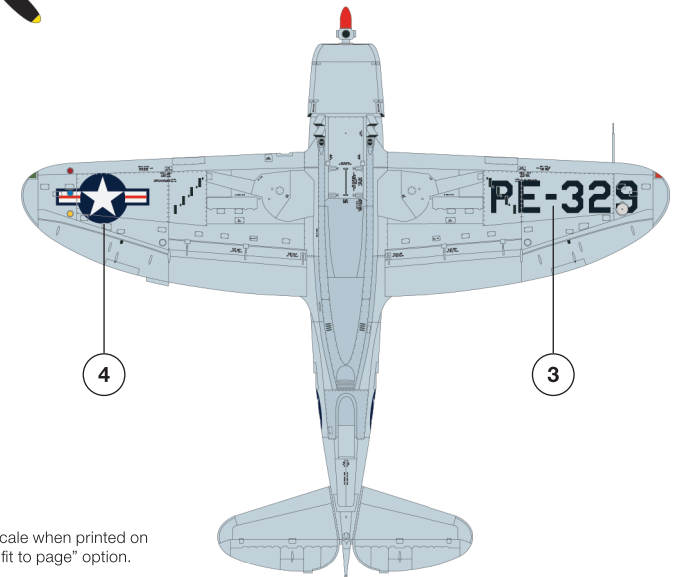

This decal set is recommended for Platz-Bego and recent F-Toys kits. Decals are made using silk print technology (BOA Bodecek Agency) and feature a limited amount of transparent base around the graphics.

F-47D-40-RA 45-49329, USAF, Wright-Patterson AFB, Ohio, summer 1947

The specially marked 'billboard' Jug was used to keep civilian aeroplanes (not fitted with radios at time) away from the military Air Base airspace. The b&w photos of this machine show darker colour of the propeller hub – when looking at photos from that era red colour seems to be most frequently used for such details – hence the red hub in our manual. The armament is removed. Underwing pylons and HVAR stubs are also gone. The full original stencilling is visible (available separately as Shelf Oddity decal set SO314431), although some stencils are covered by white 'billboard' area.
